## Irrigation plus electricity can be fatal


Irrigation is an essential part of farming, but mixed with electricity it can be dangerous



Accidental contact between irrigators and overhead power lines is a genuine concern on New Zealand farms, with at least one fatality occurring each year.

Follow our top tips to ensure safety and avoid outages on your farm:

- **Distance** Keep irrigators at least 4m away, ideally further, from overhead lines
- **Placement** Ensure jet irrigators and the booms of rotary irrigators are not directed at power lines
- Movement Make sure pipes or metal parts aren't accidentally swung into lines
- Power Treat every electric wire as live at all times
- **Guide wires** Take care working around the guide wires on electrical poles bumping these wires can cause the lines to sag.
